Classroom Spanish Activities We Love:

Interactive Storytelling:	Teachers engage in the target language with students by asking story-related questions.
Group Games:	These are mostly review games, in which the class as a whole supports a common goal.
Reading:	Spanish or Bilingual stories are selected to fit the interests of students as well as match their learning levels.
Series Work:	Students act out a familiar activity first in English, then gradually in Spanish (Gouin Series Method).
Songs and Rhymes:	Traditional selections chosen from around the Spanish-speaking world. Most contain cultural, holiday, or various vocabulary unit themes.
Busy Work:	Table Activities include worksheets, vocabulary puzzles, Spanish copy work, flash card review, and other brief assignments.
Cultural Crafts:	Arts & crafts provide a fun, "Spanish-only" immersion setting in which students can apply what they learn about styles and traditions of another culture.
